

CHURCH PARADE 4 Jan 42

S E C U R I T Y

- (a) There will be a full Regimental Church Parade for all ranks on Sunday, 4 Jan 42, at 0930 hrs at BATTLE PARISH CHURCH (opposite Battle Abbey).
- (b) Sqns. will use their own tpt. and all trucks may be used. They will be parked in the Abbey harbour area and grounds.
- (c) At 0900 hrs. the regiment will form up on the Square outside the Abbey, facing it in Sqn. column from right to left: HQ, X B, A, and C. The R.S.M. will turn over the parade not later than 0915 hrs.
- (d) Dress: Greatcoats, Respirators Slung, Without side-arms.
- (e) Drivers will remain with their trucks. Each truck will carry one Bren L.M.C. and one full magazine carrier for protection. AA Troop will mount one Bren LMG in the church yard by 0900 hrs.
- (f) Sqn Leaders will see that essential guards and picquets are left for the protection of Squadron areas.
- (g) As this is the first opportunity we have had of attending Divine Service as a regiment for sometime, the Commanding Officer expects a very high degree of personal smartness from all ranks.
